BEAVER PELTS PLENTY IN CAMPBELLTON.

CAMPBELLTON, N. B., March 24—The story of Campbellton men wearing beaver coats, as told in the Telegraph of Monday, is founded on fact, but as to when the beaver pelts were obtained your correspondent is not in a position to say, but he is informed that large numbers have been killed along the International Railway, and that almost daily the skins are being offered for sale. With respect to killing big game, your correspondent hears that at last some steps are being taken to prevent the slaughter of moose, which has annually taken place at this season of the year. Chief Warden Doyle, of Newcastle, came here last night and today went into the Tobique country and found the carcass of a newly killed moose at the homes of two residents of that section. The warden returned to town, and warrants have been sworn out for their arrest. The local game wardens, in the opinion of many, are not sufficiently vigilant in tracing out violations of the law.

THREE MEN KILLED IN REVELSTOKE.

WINNIPEG, March 24—Three men employed in blasting rock for the new power dam of Revelstoke (B.C.), hydro-electric plant, lost their lives today. The victims are Gus Laakso, a Swede; John Osur, an Icelander; and M. J. Mackay. The men were working on a platform under an overhanging ledge of rock, when a slab, eight feet by twelve, fell from above, crushing them to death. Six other men who were working below escaped injury.

HALIFAX CASHIER HELD ON CHARGE OF STEALING \$1,500.

HALIFAX, March 24—Frederick Roast, former cashier of the Dominion Express Company in Halifax, was committed for trial today on a charge of misappropriating \$1,500 of the company's funds and the forgery of cheques. If he elects to be tried before a jury, Roast will have to wait till next October, the spring term having just ended.

WILL TAKE ACTION AGAINST HOTEL.

ST. JOHN, March 24—Colonel and Mrs. George W. Jones returned on the Boston train yesterday from the Southern States. To a reporter, Colonel Jones gave further details of the theft from them in a Savannah hotel, when a large amount of money and jewelry was stolen. It is believed, he said, that the burglary was the work of crooks that followed wealthy Americans to Palm Beach as many of the latter were returning at the time he and Mrs. Jones were in Savannah. As these thieves dress well, they are enabled to stay at the best hotels and attract no suspicion. The room was probably entered by a window, the fire escape being used. The money was taken from his pocket and as his name was on the wallet the thief or thieves returned this to the pocket. The jewelry belonging to Mrs. Jones was left on the bureau and the entire lot, valued at about \$1,700, was taken. There was \$300 in money. It was only from the fact that the colonel slept with his watch and chain under his pillow that this was saved. Colonel Jones thinks that it was more fortunate than otherwise that he did not awaken as he says that these people are well armed and should he have shown any signs that he was aware of their presence he would likely have been roughly dealt with and perhaps killed, as criminals of that calibre take no chances with a prison sentence, as most of them are wanted for various crimes. It is his purpose to take action against the hotel for the recovery of the amount of his loss as he has been advised by a Savannah lawyer that he has a good case. The fact that they were continuously in their room has strengthened their case, had they been out for any interval, the hotel would have felt relieved of responsibility. His counsel's advice, consequently, is that they had not ample protection from the hotel proprietors.

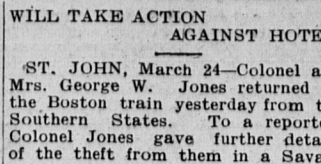

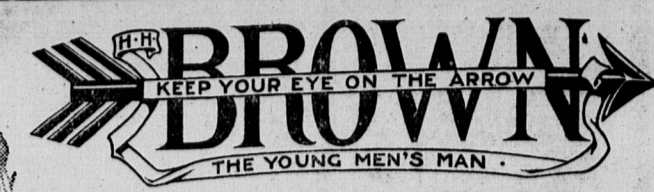
