## PREACHER ATTACKS ABUSE OF WEALTH

New York July 7.—Preaching for the last time before his long summer vacation, in Plymouth church, the Rev. Dr. Newell Dwight Hills chose for his subject: "A man's gift maketh room for him; he shall stand before kings." "Young men," said Dr. Hills, "do not make the mistake at the outset of your career of saying, 'The world owes me a living.' Of all the black lies that ever defaced the page of a man's life that is the blackest. The world does not owe you a living, but instead you owe the world a million, million livings. You can never repay what the world has done for you. There are men living in palaces in Fifth avenue and in palaces in Great Britain," he exclaimed, "who are as surely financed paupers as if they lived in hovels and were supported by the state, and there are women who carry a donkey's load of finery on their backs who should also be classed as paupers, because of the little that they give to the world in proportion to what they receive."

Dr. Hills referred to the troublous times in Russia, and said: "The French revolution will be as a match in the night in comparison with the revolution Russia is soon to have, and the aristocrats will reap what they have sown in firebrands and bullets." Dr. Hills then referred to the unrest in this country. "For the last three weeks," he said, "we have been listening to endless attacks on property. We have heard we are going to the devil because we are so rich a country; that we need to go back to the days when we could not boast so much wealth. But what this country needs isn't more poverty, but more manhood to use the property we have. God meant men to go toward wealth; he wants us to multiply our possessions. The trouble is not that we are too rich, but our knowledge, our intellectuality, our honesty, have not kept in advance of our property as they should have done. We need to come back to the convictions of our fathers and spiritualize our wealth and property."

## SPIRIT DID NOT GET AWAY QUICK

LONDON, July 7.—How a ghost was seized was described at the Edgware police court recently when Frederick Foster Craddock, of Gainsville, Grove Estate, Pinner, answered three summonses accusing him of: "Unlawfully using certain subtle craft, means, or device, by palmistry or otherwise, to deceive Lieut-Colonial Mayhew." W. Turner, for the prosecution explained that the summonses were taken out under the Act of George the Fourth, which laid down that a person guilty of these practices was a rogue and a vagabond. The defendant, he said, acted as a medium, and professed to call down the spirit of the prosecutor's child, who was not dead, then his "Uncle George," who was non-existent, and his mother, who was alive and well. Lieutenant Colonel Mayhew, accompanied by Captain Carlton, attended a seance when the medium was asked to communicate with a brother officer, said to be dead. When the supposed apparition of the officer appeared the prosecutor seized it; Captain Carlton turned on an electric light, with which he had provided himself, and discovered that Craddock was acting as medium and apparition. Counsel added that the seances were opened with prayer, the hymns "Lead Kindly Light" and "Nearer My God, to Thee" being sung. The seance was an orgie of blasphemy.

## AIMED TO DESTROY JAPAN'S COLONIES

TOKYO, July 7.—The special train bearing Marquis Ito, Japanese Resident in Korea, on his way from Japan, was stalled Saturday, as it was approaching Seoul. The whole recent palace plot at Seoul has now been unravelled. The leader in it was an eunuch named Hong Chai-Pong, who is closest to the Emperor. His plans included the destruction of the Japanese settlement at Seoul. Reliable private advices indicate that the uprising in Korea is not national. The plan of the new Chinese organization of the province of Kwantung will be published shortly. It is understood that in essentials it will resemble that which the Japanese have established in Formosa, except that the Governor-General will have greater military power. The civil department will include a Consular Service under the supervision of the Governor. A full general, with military and naval staffs, will command the Japanese garrison of the Manchurian peninsula and the Manchurian railway guards. Apparently this is Japan's reply to Russia's announced purpose to re-establish a vicereignty at Harbin, with Gen. Linevitch as Viceroy.
