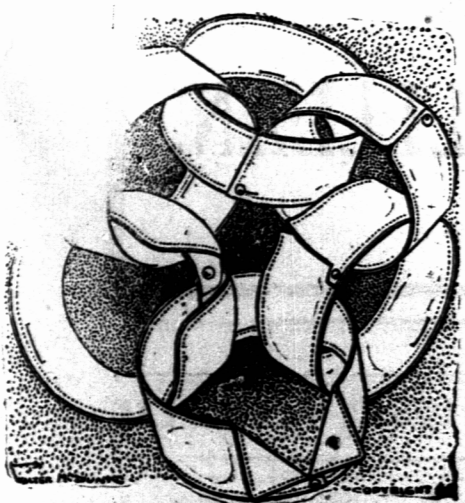

**A MEETING OF PATRONS OF WINSLOE**

Held in Harrington Hall on Thursday Night

**THE MONOPLY DISCUSSED**

Resolutions Adopted, Tendering Welcome to Davis and Fraser and Condemning Guarantee.

In response to the request of the Cheese Board a meeting of the patrons of Winsloe factory was held in Harrington Hall on Thursday evening, 30th instant. There was a fairly full house, from sixty to seventy-five being present. Charles Bryenton, President of the factory occupied the chair. Mr. Palmer, M.L.A., being called upon, gave a brief and clear outline of the proposals before the Government disclaiming any desire to influence the views of those present. His address was much appreciated. After hearing from the other speakers he expressed himself as strongly opposed to guaranteeing the bonds of the Dominion Packing Company. Short addresses were made by J. Shaw, Duncan Shaw, Isaac Essory, Edward Shaw, Frederick Essory, Peter Stewart and others. The circular from the Cheese Board and the prospectus of Davis & Fraser which were read from the chair formed the text for most of the remarks made. After the discussion a resolution was adopted tendering a cordial welcome to Davis & Fraser to establish a pork-packing industry on the Island. A second resolution was adopted condemning in strong terms the proposed action of the Government in guaranteeing the bonds, or giving a bonus to the Dominion Packing Company or to any other company. A third resolution was adopted to appoint a delegate to represent the factory at the Cheese Board. Peter Stewart was chosen for that duty. The resolutions were all adopted without a dissenting voice.

**ALL NEWS OF LOCAL INTEREST**

Reporters and Correspondents Every where.

The Rev. W. C. Cox M. A. will preach in St. Peter's Cathedral on Sunday evening at 7 o'clock.

The following subjects will be discussed at the Central Christian Church on Lord's Day: (1) Morning—"Christ in the Valley and the Shadow of Death" (2) Evening—"What think ye of Christ?"

The Sacrament of the Lord's Supper will be disposed at Merry Harbor, North Church D. V. next Sabbath, Rev. Mr. Stewart, Wood Island, officiating. Preparatory service on Saturday at 2 o'clock.

There will be a Public Gospel Meeting in Upper Great George Street church, open to all, on Sunday at 4 p. m. The lesson will be found in Hebrews 3-15, "Today." A service of song will begin at 3.45.

The sentencing of Cook to be hanged on Jan. 13, recalls the other trial held in Halifax in the autumn of 1865, when Henry Dowcey was put on trial for the murder of the captain of the brig Zero on the high seas in September, 1865. It will be recalled that brig was found by fishermen, abandoned in the harbor of Lunenburg, and it afterwards transpired that a murder had been committed on board, and that the perpetrator had abandoned the ship after making an attempt to scuttle her in an endeavor to hide the crime. After the murder the body of the captain was thrown into the sea. The Zero sailed from New York in August for Cow Bay, C. B., to load coal for Boston. During the voyage trouble arose, which culminated in the death of the captain.—Recorder.

DETAILS of the death on Monday, October 15, of Alexander B. Barnard, at Hilaracks, Demarara, already referred to in the despatches, show that too close application to business resulted in Mr. Barnard's health breaking down. He suffered from fever, which left him practically an invalid. He was affected by strange hallucinations and frequently would exclaim that he would be drowned. The Friday evening before his death he discharged a shot gun, then ran into the brush, and was with difficulty persuaded to return. On Monday, he rose very early, and left his house. A companion heard the report of a fire arm shortly afterwards, and running out saw Mr. Barnard lying dead, with blood issuing from the mouth and a revolver clasped in his hand. At the inquest a verdict was returned to the effect that deceased came to his death by committing suicide while suffering from temporary insanity induced by ill health. Mr. Barnard was a native of Charlottetown. He was manager of the gold mining firm of Barnard & Co., Demerara.
