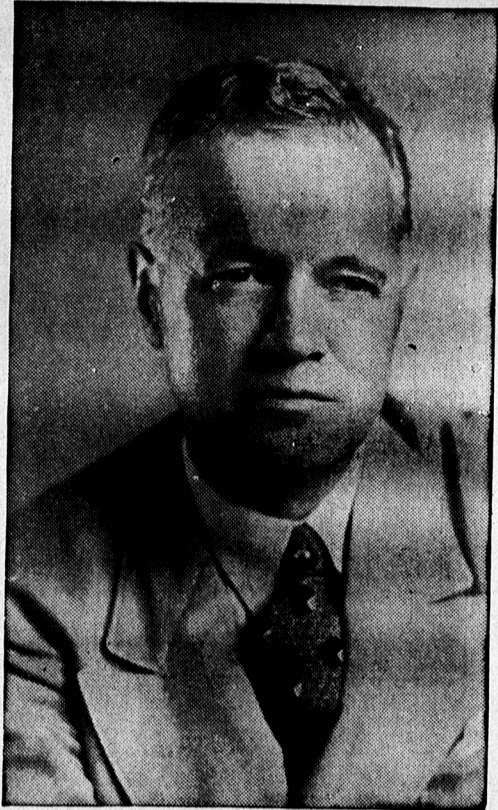

The membership has passed the 100,000 mark with a total at October 31st last of 102,873.

The total includes 41,037 Wolf Cubs, 49,909 Boy Scouts, 2,871 Rover Scouts, 713 Sea Scouts, 344 Rover Sea Scouts, 503 Lone Scouts and 8,886 leaders.

In affiliation, 754 Groups were under denominational, 435 Anglican, 65 Baptist, 46 Canadian Legion, 21 Hebrew, 29 Latter Day Saints, 3 Lutheran, 107 Presbyterian, 326 Roman Catholic, 59 Salvation Army, 272 United Church, 59 sponsored by service clubs and 16 connected with children's hospitals.
