FAMOUS NOVELIST IS DEAD IN LONDON.

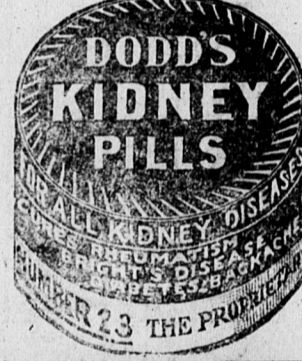
