**NEW BATTLESHIPS FOR UNITED STATES**

 LONDON, July 3.—A despatch to the Daily Mail from Shanghai says Viceroy Chun reports officially that the Boxer rising in Sze-Chuen province, when a Methodist chapel was reported destroyed and 10 converts killed, has been suppressed and the leaders executed.
