NEW YORK, Jan. 26—(AP)—Quiet strength appeared here and there in today's stock market but many issues stalled in lower territory.  
Bethlehem Steel's better than expected December quarter earnings figures lifted the company's 5 and 7 per cent preferreds 1 to 2 points to new 1940 peaks. U. S. Steel and Bethlehem common slipped at the last.  
Canadian stocks were generally lower. Dome, Walkers, Ford and Imperial Oil eased fractionally as Shawinigan and Lake Shore moved forward.  
The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was unchanged at 49.9. Transfers totaled 693,885 shares against \$43,570 the day before.  
Improved outlook for warplane purchases buoyed the aviation stocks. Progress was recorded by shares of Douglas, United Aircraft, Glenn Martin, Sperry and Lockheed. Heavy passenger traffic boosted Eastern Air Lines and American Airlines.  
General Motors and Chrysler retained small improvement, American Power & Light preferreds dropped 2 to 3 points. Down were Brooklyn and American Telephone.  
TORONTO, Jan. 26—(CP)—The stock market registered a slow decline today with volume showing little change from the recent average. Base metal stocks weakened 33 in the index, the industrials lost 12. The golds 43 and the western oils 62. Aggregate turnover was 309,000 shares.
