Miss Olive McKernan of Newport was a recent guest of Mr. and Mrs. Guy Hemphill.

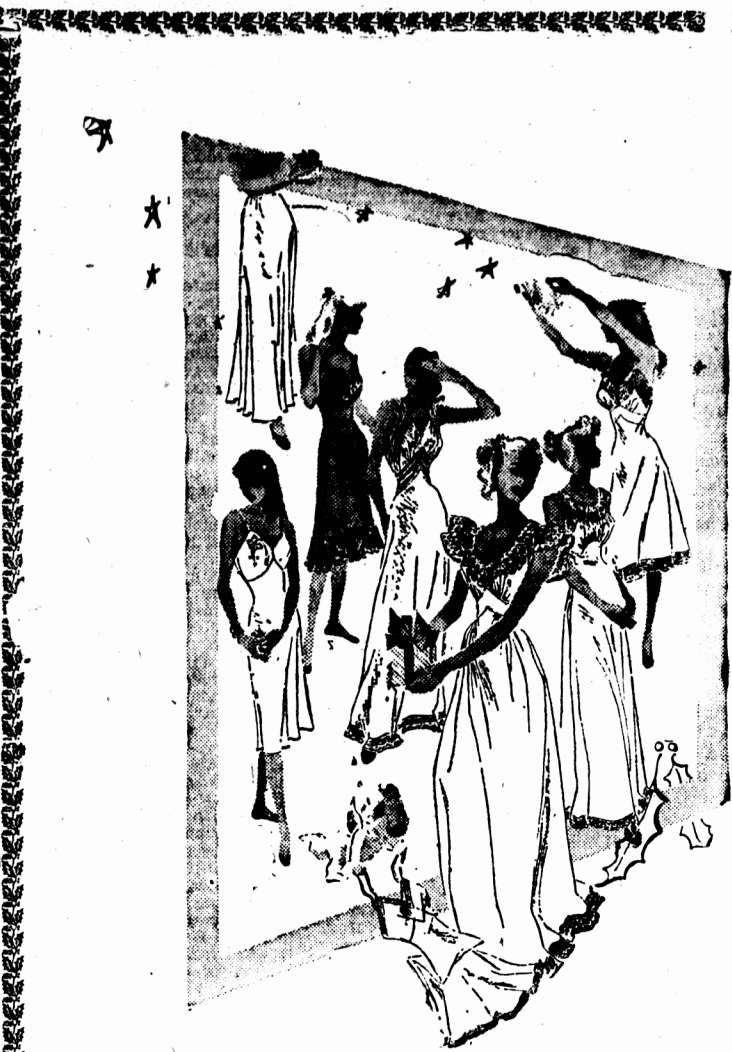
The many friends of Mrs. Anne D. White will be glad to hear that she has returned to her home on Sydney St. after having spent a few days in the P.E.I. Hospital.
