PATIENCE

Patience is often—to often—looked upon as a sort of weak thing. The word is a picture, and is from the root "to suffer"; and when we look at it in the original it is very expressive. For instance, we have the picture of one who remains behind after all have left the field. It has staying power. Or again it may represent a person holding up a load; he is under it and the load is not easy. Moreover, when Peter, in his second letter would give a list, and a graduated list, of the virtues which we should cultivate, he puts patience next to godliness (2 Peter, 1:5-7). These virtues are really notes in an octave. Patience is far up the scale. It comes after temperance, for there can be no patience if self-control is not achieved.

Strange to say patience and self-control are derived from the same root, so they are related, twins in a sense, though one is active and the other passive.

When we think of God surely one of the attributes that first comes to mind is His patience. In fact, Paul calls Him "the God of patience." His power is seen in nature. A Psalmist says: "the sea is His and He made it and His hands formed the dry land." A Hebrew prophet declares that He holds the sea in the palm of His hand. "He prescribes its limitations. But is not His patience that which impresses us even more? When we think that we have seen two wars with all their attendant hate and cruelty in our time and
