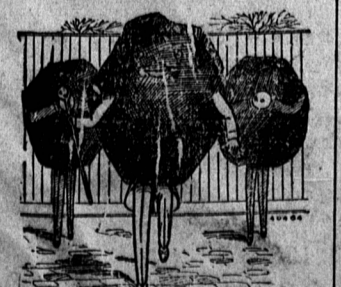

DELINQUENT GIRLS HOME SOON READY

TRURO, June 27.—The Maritime Home for Delinquent Girls at Truro will be opened on September 1st and accommodation for about fifteen girls will then be available. This was the decision arrived at by the Board of Governors which was created on Thursday at a meeting of the provincial organization. The new home will be open for wayward girls under sixteen years of age and it is hoped to have a substantial brick building as soon as possible. Already \$20,000 has been collected as a new building fund and Rev. V. M. Purdy will be continued as financial agent. The governments of the three provinces have promised aid for the home.

The Board of Governors as elected on Thursday is as follows: Rev. Dr. J. W. McMillan, Halifax, chairman; His Lordship Bishop Richardson, vice-chairman; Rev. C. E. Glendening, New Glasgow, secretary-treasurer; Rev. H. E. Thomas and Rev. Gordon Dickie, of St. John, are also members of the board.

The building at present on the property are being renovated and put in proper condition for the opening of the home. The building is well under way but a start on the structure will not likely be made till next year.

The superintendent and matron have already been appointed and they will be ready to take up their duties as soon as necessary.

Dr. T. Albert Moore of Toronto, general secretary of the temperance and moral reform department of the Methodist Church and Rev. J. G. Shearer of Toronto, general secretary of the Presbyterian Church, were at the meeting and took part in the discussion of the matters considered.

The initial steps in connection with the establishment of this home were taken about a year ago when people prominent in the Presbyterian churches of Nova Scotia brought the matter to the attention of the public. The temperance and moral reform department of the Presbyterian church then took definite steps to interest other denominations until now the governing board is made up of seven Presbyterians, seven Methodists, three Baptists and three Episcopalians.

The provisional committee of organization was created and it conducted the campaign that led to the establishment of the home, until Thursday, when the permanent board took over the control.

A large farm at Truro was bought at a cost of \$6,000 and the members of the board in Truro this week were delighted with the property for such a home. The first accommodation will be for fifteen girls, but later on this will be increased as needed.
