A recent meeting of Roman Catholic Archbishops in Ottawa is said to have had relation to the desire on the part of the Hierarchy to bring about a revision of the declaration to be made by King Edward at his coronation. It is understood that representations have been made to the Canadian Government for transmission to the Imperial Government asking that there may be excluded from the coronation oath, or declaration certain phrases which are thought objectionable by or offensive to Catholics. As to the chances of the success of this movement it is to be observed that British opinion is very conservative, and in all that pertains to the accession of the King ancient forms and precedents have been very scrupulously adhered to.

It is said in Ottawa, but on what authority we do not know, that the coronation of King Edward will take place on 24th May, 1902. This seems a distant date but it will be remembered that Queen Victoria was not publicly crowned until something more than a year after her accession.

OTTAWA, Jan. 5.—(Special)—Sir Alfred Milner cables that French of the Strathcona Horse died at Bloemfontein of enteric fever.

FIGHT AT MODDERSTONTEIN.

LONDON, Feb. 3.—(Special)—Lord Kitchener reports casualties at Modderfontein were two officers killed two wounded.

The post was rushed on a pitch dark night during a pouring rain by fourteen hundred Boers.

CAMPBELL ENGAGES THE BOERS.

Col. Campbell at South Middleburg engaged five hundred Boers who were driven back with loss.

Gen. French near Bethel is moving east and driving the enemy.

PORTUGUESE SIEGE BOER AMMUNITION.

Four of our ambulances have been captured.

Dewet is reported south of Dewetstorp.

All the ammunition surrendered by the Boers at Koomatiport has been loaded on lighters and anchored in the bay at Lorenzo Marques.
