**CHURCH PROBE FOR GOGORZA**

PARIS, Sept. 17—In regard to the difficulties which are alleged to have arisen in connection with the marriage of Mme. Emma Eames, the prima donna, to Emilio Gogorza, celebrated in the Church of St. Pierre DeChailot, July last, it was stated yesterday by the locum tenens for Mgr. Amette, archbishop of Paris who is at present out of town, that information had been lodged to the effect that Mr. Gogorza had previously gone through a marriage ceremony.

"We are not yet informed, however, whether the alleged previous marriage of Gogorza was a religious or civil ceremony. If it was a religious one, the ceremony which he went through with Mme. Eames will, of course, be declared void by the church, but if it was merely a civil marriage, the matter will be referred to Rome.

Full details were so lacking that the archbishop, who took special interest in the matter and was investigating the facts, will shortly make a full report of the subject to Rome. It is, of course, well known that Mme. Eames had a husband who is still living," added Mgr. Amette's deputy, "but in her case what is technically
