## SECRET OF DUSTLESS ROADS.

(Woman's World.)  
Some bright day the United States will wake up and find itself running around on roads that have not a speck of dust on them. The practice of oiling roads and of trading them with other bituminous materials has grown tremendously. Already there is a great demand for information from the office of Public Roads in Washington on how to keep dust out of the thoroughfares of the city and the country. At present the following six classes of materials are used for this purpose:

1. Petroleum and petroleum products, including residual petroleum, fluxes, oil asphalt; and fluxed or cut back oil asphalt.
2. Malthas.
3. Asphalts and other solid native and synthetic asphaltic cements produced by fluxing them.
4. Tars and tar products.
5. Mixtures of tar with petroleum or asphalt products, bituminous emulsions and factitious asphalts.
6. Bituminous aggregates, including rock asphalts of bituminous rocks, bituminous concrete and asphalt, or other bituminous topping.
