**Indifference Rules New York Stock Exchange**

NEW YORK, Feb. 28 (AP)—Assorted stocks continued to achieve some headway in today's market but leaders generally refused to follow through on Thursday's rally and dealings were among the slowest of the year to date.

Indifference ruled from the start, the ticker tape frequently dozed. Declines of fractions to a point or more predominated at the close. Coppers such as Anaconda, Kennecott and Phelps Dodge edged forward in the final half hour, when the Reconstruction Finance Corp. announced it was raising its selling price for the metal to approximately 21 1-2 cents a pound.

Transfers of 680,000 shares compared with 970,000 the day before and were a low for a full stretch since Jan. 22. The Associated Press 60-stock composite was off 1/4 of a point at 66 1/4. It was the narrowest market since Jan. 22.

Among Canadian issues, Dominion Mines lost 3-8 and McIntyre fell 1/2 point while Canadian Pacific and Dilliers Seagram both were unchanged. On the curb, Lake Shore and Giant Yellow each moved up 1/4.

On the rising side where Eastman Kodak up 5/8 at 235, as split up talk was heard. Crown Zellerbach up 1/4 at 31 1-4 and International Minerals up 3/4 at 29 7/8 on increased quarterly payments.

Most improvement was retained by Pullman, Standard Oil (NJ), American Woven, North American, Consolidated Edison, American Can, Safeway Stores, Woolworth, Chrysler, and Bethlehem Steel.

All Western conceded 3-1-2 at 244. Southern Pacific 1 at 43 1-4. Youngstown Sheet 1 1-8 at 63 7-8. Owens-Illinois 1 1-4 at 74. Standard Oil of Cal. 1 1-2 at 53. J. C. Penney 1 3-8 at 43 7-8 and Du Pont 1 at
