### MORNING STOCK LETTER

(Received over Pittfield and Co's Private Wire)

NEW YORK, June 22—News this morning is generally unfavorable again. The London market is lower probably due to the cancellation of the proposed visit of Baron Von Neurath which was scheduled to take place tomorrow and also the French situation. Domestically, labor difficulties continue to dominate the news. The reopening of the Youngstown Sheet and Tube plant and the Republic Steel Plant at Youngstown scheduled for this morning has been cancelled at the request of Governor of Ohio and President of the United States. Dividend meetings scheduled for today include American Light and Traction, Hershey Chocolate, McCall, Link Belt and United Gas Improvement. Market has backed and filled in a comparatively narrow range in the last seven days and the news this morning is certainly unfavorable enough to provide for another real test. The action of the rails in the last half hour yesterday was not favorable and we would look on the first thing this morning because at the close last night-market looked lower.

MONTREAL, June 22—May earnings Donnacona \$57,399 before depreciation and depletion available bond interest of \$2,946 and note interest of \$3,078 which compared with \$35,597 for April 1937 and \$24,215 in May 1936. For five months ended May 1937 company earned \$194,404 against interest on bonds of \$104,246 and notes of \$9,233 as compared with \$35,924 in the corresponding period in 1936. These shares were issued as consideration for 15,000, 50 per cent paid up shares of Fraser Realities Ltd. purchased by the company. Total number of issued shares is now 371,018.

Canadian Asbestos Shipments—For month of April up 30 per cent over March 1937 and 115 per cent over April 1936 and for first four months this year gained 80 per cent over same period last year.
