Stock Prices Move Lower In New York

BY FREDERICK GARDNER Associated Press Financial Editor NEW YORK, April 17.—(AP)—With no especially helpful change in either the European scene or the domestic business picture, the stock market today stepped back fractions to more than three points at the worst. Light buying support in the afternoon lifted prices above the low, but there was little vigor in the few and brief rallying periods.

Transfers of \$24,040 shares were the smallest since March 29, and compared with Friday's next lightest session when the turnover was \$19,860. The Associated Press average of 60 issues was off 9 of a point at 43 1/8.

The Canadian department was generally lower with most issues inactive. Distillers Seagram dropped 1 point to 16 and International Nickel 1 1/4 to 45 5/8 while Dome and Walkers lost sizeable fractions.
