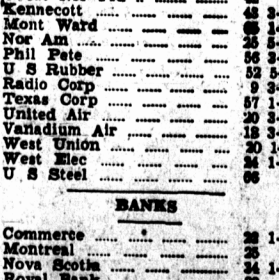

MONTREAL, Oct. 9 (CP) - Prices worked downward in light transfers today on the stock exchange and curb market in sympathy with New York. Losses made a grand slam in the indices. Individually they had an advantage of almost five to one over gains.

Canadian Issues Skid Downward on New York Market

NEW YORK, Oct. 9 (AP) - Prices of leading stocks were hammered down one to more than 7 points in today's market for the sharpest break in nearly three weeks.

All sections of the list broke through previous 1946 lows as the Associated Press 60-stock composite dropped 1.9 points to 59.4 bottom since March 27, 1945.

Led by Hiram Walker's three point loss, Canadian issues skidded downward. McIntyre dropped 2 1-2. Disillers Seagram 1-8. Canadian Pacific 7-8 and Dome Mines 1-4. On the curb, Lake Shore slipped 1-4 and Giant Yellowknife 1-8.

Chrysler was off 3-7-8 at 79 3-8. Union Pacific was another wide loser, closing at 110 3-4 down 7 1-4.

Others with sharp drops included Santa Fe, off 4 1/4 at 80; Du Pont 4-7-8 at 170 1-8; U. S. Rubber 3-8 at 52 5-8; Youngstown Sheet 3-8 at 59; Coco Cola 4-3-4 at 130; and Packard 1-2 at 60.

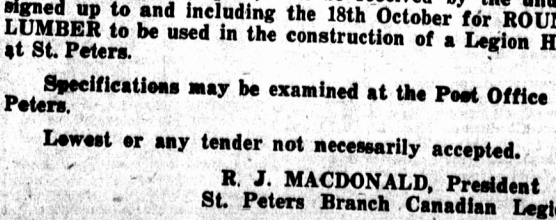
