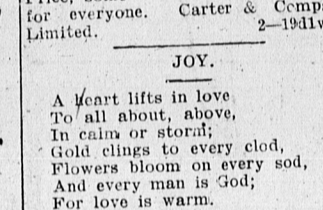

Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family or any male over 18 years old, may have a grant of a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or sub-Agency in the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of the landholder.
