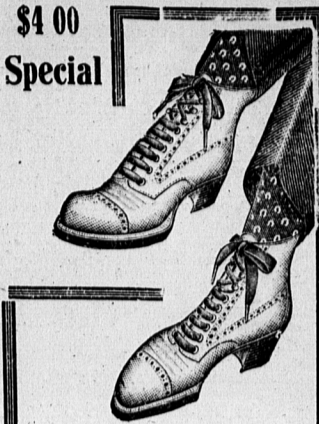

Writing to the Boston Herald in answer to four questions, Miss Lucy M. Montgomery of Cavendish, the well known authoress, expressed herself as follows on the two last queries—'The third question isn't a question at all, but a calm, maddening statement' with a slightly rising inflection. It is: 'I suppose you are completely frozen up down there by this time?' 'Down there' means Prince Edward Island, and 'frozen up' means that steamship communication with the mainland is interrupted. Frozen up in November! Heaven grant me patience. In the worst of years we are never 'frozen up' until February. Then for a week or 10 days the ice in the strait way is so thick that the steamers cannot cut through it, and the 'ice boats' are out on it to carry passengers and mails. But this happens only about once a winter out of three. We rarely have lasting snow until after Christmas. Last winter, as I remember, wheels ran every month, and the snow never stayed long enough to make roads for sleighing. Of course, we have an occasional severe and stormy winter; but we are never frozen up in November. The fourth question is: 'Wouldn't you like to live up here?' To that I must answer 'No.' I have enjoyed my sojourn among you most heartily; but noble as your land is, it is not my land; friendly and delightful as your people are, they are not 'mine own people'; beautiful as your starry banner is, it is not my old flag that has 'braved a thousand years the battle and the breeze.' Only in the shadow of that old flag could I wish to make my home. But, oh, you are nice to visit!
