Shrunk Woolens  
Woolens that have shrunk can be brought back to their normal size by rinsing them in fresh soapwater instead of clear water after washing. Repeat each time the garment is washed until the correct size is obtained.  
Washing Glassware  
Be sure never to put glassware into the hot dish water bottom first, as this may result in its cracking from the sudden expansion. Slip the glasses in edgewise, and the danger will be eliminated.  
Windows That Stick

#### JELLY FRUIT SALAD DRESSING

2-3 cup sweetened condensed milk  
1-4 cup vinegar or lemon juice  
1-4 cup salad oil or melted butter  
1 egg yolk  
1-2 teaspoon salt  
Few grains cayenne  
1 teaspoon dry mustard  
1-2 cup tart red jelly such as currant or cranberry  
Place all ingredients except jelly in mixing bowl. Beat with rotary egg beater until mixture thickens. If thicker consistency is desired, place in refrigerator to chill before serving. Just before serving, add jelly. Makes 1-2-4 cups.

#### STUFFED FISH A LA NUBURG

2 pounds of fillets, or any whole fish  
2 cups of soft, fine, bread crumbs  
1 teaspoon of mixed poultry seasoning  
1 teaspoon of salt  
Dash of pepper  
1 tablespoon of onion juice  
2 tablespoons of melted fat or butter  
1/2 cup of milk, or more if the bread crumbs are not soft

Clean and bone the fish, or wipe the fillets with a damp cloth. Mix the other ingredients to form a dressing and stuff the whole fish; or place a fillet on a greased pan with the dressing on top of it and another fillet over the dressing. Make the following sauce and pour over the fish:  
1 tablespoon of butter or fat, melted  
1 tablespoon of flour sifted in and blended  
2 cups of milk

Cook until thick, stirring to keep smooth. Add 6 oysters or 1/2 cup of lobster, flaked (oysters or lobster optional) and 1 egg yolk, hard-cooked and sliced.  
Bake the fish in this sauce in a 400° F. oven until "set", allowing about 10 minutes for each inch thickness of fish. Serves 6 or 7.

#### CREAMED FISH IN HOT BISCUITS

Combine 1 1/2 cups of flaked, cooked or canned fish and 2 tablespoons of chopped pickles with 1 cup of medium white sauce. Season with salt, pepper and a dash of cayenne. Bake rich, baking powder biscuits, split and butter while hot and serve with the creamed fish between the layers and over the top. Hot, buttered asparagus is a good accompaniment.

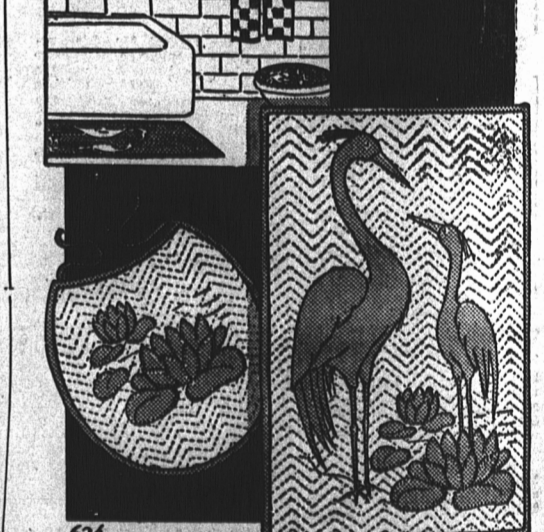
