Island as follows: Trout, Oct 1st to March 31 following; Smelts, April 1st to June 30; lobsters, June 28th to April 25 on all coast excepting from West Point to Eastern entrance Victoria Harbor and October 16th to August 15th from West Point to Eastern entrance Victoria Harbor; Salmon, (netting) August 16th to February 28th; and from Sept 16th to March 31st (angling); oysters, Jan. 1st to Sept. 30 on public beds and from July 1st to August 31st on leased areas; quahogs, July 1st to Aug. 31 and Oct. 1st to May 10th; scallops, June 1st to October 15th; smelt fishing season (gill-nets), Oct. 15th to February 15th; bag-nets Dec. 1st to Feb. 15th. All dates mentioned inclusive.

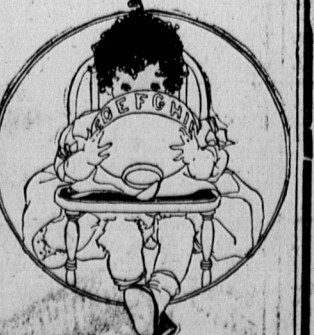

TEACHERS TO TOUR ON THE CONTINENT Party of 200 Will Visit Battlefields Under Overseas Education League.

TORONTO, May 3. - For the first time since 1914 parties of Canadian teachers are to tour England and the continent during the summer vacation. Under the auspices of the Overseas Education League, the reorganized "Hands Across the Sea" movement, a party of two hundred, representative of every province in the Dominion, will sail from Montreal on the Tunisian on June 30th. The trip will require about two months and the itinerary includes a fortnight's visit to the battlefields of Northern France and Belgium. The estimated cost of the trip from Winnipeg is stated as \$450, which amount would be somewhat reduced for teachers starting from Ontario. Following a meeting of repre-

representatives of the departments of education of the various provinces in Quebec last winter it was agreed that the departments should cooperate in the work of the institution known as "Hands Across the Sea" and the name of the institution was changed to "Overseas Education League." Recognition has now effected. His Excellency the Duke of Devonshire is president, His Grace Archbishop Matheson, Chancellor of the University of Manitoba, vice-president and Major F. J. Ney, of Winnipeg, is organizing secretary. The league has undertaken to arrange exchanges of teachers within the Empire and although the branch of the work has only recently been resumed, already 34 teachers are under way. Three teachers sailed from New Zealand on the 12th of the month and will spend a year in the Western Provinces. The Toronto Board of Education has granted leave of absence to over thirty teachers who expect to spend next year teaching in London, England.
