## RHODES AS A PACIFIER.

LONDON, Dec. 7.—Cecil Rhodes, as the pacifier of South Africa, promises to be one of the realities of the near future in British Imperial affairs. From an officer of high rank, who has just returned from the Cape, as a correspondent received the following statement:—

"South Africa seriously needs the services of the great peacemaker. My intimate knowledge of Mr. Rhodes' opinions at this moment causes me to have little doubt that he intends to have take advantage of the unparalleled opportunity now open to him. He may be expected to come out shortly as an advocate of conciliatory measures likely to end the war, and make the situation afterwards tolerable to both races. Even the dutch, as much as they hate Cecil Rhodes, feel that there is no other man who could succeed in the undertaking suggested. There is absolutely no doubt that the wave of concilia-

tion is rapidly gathering strength. Last week your correspondent wired that Mr. Rhodes had evolved a plan of federation for South Africa. That plan embraces his scheme of reconciliation and pacification. It offers the belligerent Dutch terms of settlement so liberal that its author believes they would readily and gladly enrol themselves under the British flag in accordance with its provisions. Mr. Rhodes is now engaged in working out the details of his stupendous program. He expects to have them completed in the course of a few weeks, when he will forward to England a literary draft of his scheme and ask her majesty's ministers to make it the government's policy in South Africa.

As soon as Rhodes' scheme is launched with a strong head it is likely that many people in all ranks and parties will join it.

### English Submarine Boat.

Admiralty to Experiment With One on the Lines of a Torpedo Destroyer

LONDON, December 9.—The Chronicle asserts that despite official and other denials it is a fact that the admiralty is trying or is about to try a submarine boat. Two naval officers have invented a special steering apparatus which has been adopted for the experiments.

The papers say it learns, but does not vouch for the accuracy of its formation, that the vessel is of the nature of a submarine torpedo boat destroyer, the object of which will be the destruction of hostile submarine boats. She will carry submarine guns, discharging a sort of small torpedo-like shell charged with gun-cotton. The charge will be exploded by an adaptation of the wireless telegraphy system.

The Chronicle adds that the method is based on the well-known fact that the explosion of a heavy charge of gun-cotton will stave the sides of any submarine boat by concussion, even if exploded at a distance of a hundred feet from the vessel fired at.

### Sued Newspaper For His Manuscript.

NEW HAVEN, Conn., December 9.—Professor Horatio W. Parker Battell, professor of music in Yale University, and author of "Hora Novissima," and other works of music, has brought suit against a local newspaper for \$5,000 damages for failure to return a manuscript, of his lecture on "Church Music." Professor Parker sets forth his complaint that on April 10, 1900, he loaned the use of the manuscript to the defendant through one of its representatives, with the understanding that it should be returned. It was not returned, according to his complaint, and he is unable to reproduce it. He valued the manuscript intrinsically at \$1,000, and his loss by failure to fulfill engagements to lecture on the subject, at \$5,000.

### A Sheldon Imitator.

LONDON, December 9.—The editor of the Sun, an afternoon half-penny paper, will hand over the editorship of that journal from December 17 to December 22 to the Rev. Joseph Parker, pastor of the City Temple, who will emulate the Rev. Mr. Sheldon, who for a time conducted the Tepeka Capital. Mr. Parker will have the entire direction and control of the paper. It is announced that he will show British journalists and the British public how, in his opinion, a newspaper should be conducted in order to effect the greatest good.
