SEE MENACE IN YOUTHFUL CHAUFFEURS.

DARTMOUTH, Nov. 11—The fact that boys are allowed to drive automobiles through the public streets is a problem that is causing many comments among the citizens of this town and will in all probability be the subject of a petition to the Town Council, asking that this practice be prohibited.

Notwithstanding the fact a number of the boys are quite capable of handling these machines, there are some minors, who although capable of steering and running the cars, are incapable of controlling the machines in a crowd. Only last week, an elderly lady, while in the act of crossing the street, narrowly escaped being run down, and upon investigation it was discovered that a boy of about 14 years of age was in charge of the car. The police have been asked on several occasions if it were not possible to have this practice stopped, but there being no law prohibiting such an action they are unable to interfere.

SIX THOUSAND MEN TO BE EMPLOYED.

MONTREAL, Nov. 11—Six thousand men will be employed by the G. T. P. during the coming winter, says Vice-President Morley Davidson. On the Western end 4,600 men are now at work and before many weeks this number will have increased to 5,000; while working Eastward from Hamilton there are at present 1,700 workmen on the main line. Practically all the necessary force for the season's operations in the mountains is now engaged and although additional men could be set to work there will be no delay even if the present number fails to be augmented. No exact forecast can be made as to the possibility of the line being completed to the Pacific Coast in 1913.

WHITE LEGHORNS WIN EGG CONTEST.

STORRS, Nov. 11—The international egg-laying competition that has been conducted the past year at the Connecticut Agricultural College at Storrs is ended and the winners have decided upon the greatest number of eggs laid. First prize was won by F. G. Yost's pen of singlecomb White Leghorns, the five hens having laid 1,071 eggs. The wonderful record of a year's time is an average of 214.2 eggs per hen.

McLeod Brothers of Stony Creek, Ont., Canada, took second prize, his pen of White Wyandottes having laid 1069 eggs. The contest was the greatest in the history of egg-laying competitions. For two months the white Wyandottes hammered away and gained sixty eggs. If the contest was to have ended two days later the Wyandottes would have won. Both pens remain in the contest for another year.
