Farm Notes

NOTES RE CORN ENSILAGE

Some of the findings resulting from experimental work in connection with corn ensilage carried out by the Division of Field Husbandry of the Dominion Experimental Farms are summarized as follows:

Corn may be cut at various stages of maturity and ensiled under varying conditions, and in most cases satisfactory ensilage is obtained.

Corn cut in the milk stage makes a good ensilage from the standpoint of palatability and general appearance, but corn cut in the dough stage contains larger amount of feed constituents and ensiling in the late dough glaze stage is recommended.

Where circumstances made a delay in the ensiling necessary satisfactory silage may be obtained from corn which has been cut ten days before ensiling. Such a practice, however, is not recommended except under unusual circumstances.

A good quality of silage can be made from slightly frozen material of good quality. Apparent slight freezing has very little detrimental effect on corn for silage.

It is not a good practice to permit corn which is to be ensiled to dry in stocks in the field. If the crop must be stockied in the field one would be well advised to draw it in and feed it as dry roughage rather than to attempt to make it into silage.

A special experiment was made last year to determine the feasibility of eliminating the actual labour cost of tramping and spreading ensilage in the silo, with satisfactory results. Apparently the weight of the ensilage itself after the silo is partially filled exerts enough pressure to exclude air without tramping. A certain amount of tramping and spreading of ensilage near the top is, however, necessary.

Ensilage may be carried over from year to year in a satisfactory condition. The contents of one silo carried two years and another carried four years at the Central Experimental Farm was eaten with relish by cows after being opened to use.

Drenching and dipping were the treatments he recommended as being very beneficial. He also dealt with breeding and feeding of hogs and lambs, and also docking and castrating as applied to the latter class.
