THE REVIVAL IN OTTAWA

OTTAWA, June 15.—Torrey is not a sensationalist but he is a heart hitter. Plain Anglo-Saxon is used to denounce modern weakness and the sins which beset and as a climax there is an appeal to the intelligence and the nobler instincts of humanity. Dr. Torrey has not yet been heard in Ottawa to play on the emotions with pathetic story and death bed scenes. He rather inclines to strong condemnation of wrong the awakening of the conscience by bluntly painting sin in its true colors. He is more likely, as a first impression to arouse mental resentment, and it strikes one sometimes that he deliberately aims at that end, and then with the manly plea urges a right intellectual attitude and the facing of eternal problem in the light of future consequence and present duty.

Last night he based his remarks on the dramatic and tragic feast of Belshazzar, and coupled with it the Thou shalt Not of Sinai.
Social sins and impurities were given sledge-hammer blows and there was no mincing of words, nor misunderstanding the arrangements. The address was forceful, logical, and worked up to a most effective climax. There was no palliation, no condoning, no extenuating circumstances. It was a straight charge, an honest portrayal of consequences, as understood by the speaker, and a square manly appeal to quit the wrong and do the right.

The musical service was quite as bright as on previous nights. Mr. Alexander's personality is inspiring and he certainly knows how to lead a choir. The Glory Song and other favorites do not seem to grow old. They rather grow in freshness as the people catch the inspiration of sentiment and learn to sing them as they should be sung.

Mr. Butler in a solo was most effective and was listened to with rapt attention. Ottawa workers are rallying nobly and do valiant work in co-operating with Dr. Torrey.

PRAIRIE PROVINCE TO BE REPRESENTED AT THE DOMINION EXHIBITION.

One of the fine exhibits at the Dominion Exhibition in Halifax this year will be that of the Province of Saskatchewan. President Lourey is in receipt of a communication from the Government of the New Provinces announcing their intention to send an exhibit to include a display of the products of those far western Provinces, pictures of ranching scenes and specimens of the forestry of the Province.

With the notice of this intention to send an exhibit came also a request that it be given a location on the spacious grounds where it may be seen to a better advantage. This will be attended to by the commission.

At the last meeting of the Exhibition Commission it was decided to prepare specifications for painting all the buildings on the Exhibition Grounds in a uniform colour with that on the three new buildings. A tender was also awarded for the construction of the new grand entrance and administration building. Work on this structure will begin at once, thus giving four new buildings along the Windsor Street front.

The Manufacturers Building is to be increased in size by the addition of 60 feet on the whole of its eastern side. The Canadian Pacific Railway will have their standard exhibit at the Dominion Fair, a splendid collection, artistically arranged, of the products of Canada's great west.

The amusement feature of the forthcoming Exhibition will be on a scale of grandeur and to secure this result Manager Hall will leave no stone unturned.

The nine days racing on the half-mile track will be for purses of \$9,000. Besides this two days will be devoted to a Horse Show, which will be given on a grand scale and in which the Halifax Riding Club will take an active and prominent part. Vaudeville attractions will be seen both night and day in front of the Grand Stand.
