MONTREAL, Sept. 11—(CP)—The market for produce was generally higher in the averages after trading today on the stock exchange and curd market. Utilities moved down a bit. Volume was low.

Better in industrials on the exchange were Bathurst and Canadian Industrial Alcohol. Niagara Falls Wire dropped a point to 100. The market was fractionally higher in the company's dividend rate. Winnipeg Electric preferred picked up a point in utilities and Montreal was fractionally higher. Easier a little were Saguenay preferred, Southern Canada Power and Brazilian.

C.P.R. raised up an early list in carriers and International Petroleum lost ground in oils.

Canadian Foreign Investment, which owns cement enterprises in Brazil, jumped 2 points to a new high in miscellaneous and posting recessions were Celanese preferred, Shearwater preferred and Legare preferred.

In banks Montreal moved down to a new low on small turnover.

### Famous Airman Reported Missing In Casualty List

OTTAWA, Sept. 9—(CP)—Wing Cmdr. John (Moose) Fulton of Kamloops, B.C., winner of the distinguished service order, distinguished flying cross and air force cross for his exploits overseas with the Royal Air Force, is missing after air operations, the Royal Canadian Air Force reported today.

Wing Cmdr. Fulton was listed as missing in July but the official Ottawa announcement was delayed slightly more than five weeks, under a recently inaugurated policy intended to make it easier for men to escape from German-occupied territory.

Leader of the famous "Moose" squadron, Wing Cmdr. Fulton won recognition both in Canada and abroad.

Announcement that he is missing came in the 35th R.C.A.F. casualty list of the war.

Contained in the list were the names of 11 other Canadian air men missing after overseas air operations, three missing and believed killed during overseas air operations and six killed on active service overseas.

The overseas section of the list also named three men previously reported missing overseas as now for official purposes presumed dead, and one seriously injured on active service overseas.

One man was reported killed on active service in Canada and one previously reported missing in Canada as now reported killed on active service.
