CHRISTMAS SHIP SAILS TOMORROW

SAN FRANCISCO, Cal., Nov. 4.—The last transport that will reach the Island of Guam and the Philippines before Christmas will sail from this port tomorrow and Col. John T. Knight, the local depot quartermaster of the U. S. army and his assistants are almost overwhelmed with work owing to the enormous number of Christmas gifts for the American soldiers in the far East which have accumulated here during the past week or so.

CREAMED LOBSTER ON TOAST

Dice the boiled lobster, and allow to stand in a little lemon juice for a few minutes. Make a white sauce rich with cream, season with cayenne and onion juice. Add the lobster for five minutes and serve on toast or in bread boxes cut round and shallow.

FRIED LOBSTER

Boil the lobster and cut into as large pieces as possible. Dip into egg and crumbs, fry in deep fat and drain on soft brown paper. Make a Hollandaise sauce in which is minced parsley and chopped olives and a few drops of onion juice.

SCALLOP STEW

Make like oyster stew, substituting one quart of scallops for oysters.

DEVILLED SCALLOPS

Clean one quart of scallops, drain and bring to the boiling point. Drain again and save the liquor. Mix well one-third cup of butter, one-third teaspoonful of made mustard, a pinch of cayenne, a teaspoonful of salt. Add to this two-thirds of the reserved liquor and the chopped scallops. Let stand for an hour, then stir well and put into a buttered baking dish. Cover with crumbs and bake twenty minutes. Try to have only two layers of scallops in the dish so that both will cook alike.

VEAL RECHAUFFE

Cook a sliced onion in a table spoon of butter till it is a delicate straw color. Add one cup of veal

stock or meat gravy, the juice from half a can of mushrooms, and two cups of cold cut-up veal. Heat and add half a can of mushrooms cut in two. Just before serving add two egg yolks well beaten. Instead of the canned mushrooms substitute fresh ones cooked with the onion for five minutes and use cream instead of the mushroom liquor.

STEWED CORN

Melt two tablespoons of butter, add one of flour and cook without browning; add one tablespoon of finely minced green pepper and one-fourth a clove of garlic sliced. Thin as soon as the pepper is soft add half a cup of cream and a can of corn. Cook till the corn is heated through.
