RUSHED TO THE GRAVE.

How Czolgosz Remains Were Disposed of.

(Buffalo Courier, Oct. 30.)

In six hours, nine minutes and thirty seconds after Czolgosz had entered the death chamber the grave diggers in the prison lot at Fort Hill Cemetery had completed their work.

Czolgosz sat down in the death chair at 7.11.30 o'clock; forty seconds later he was pronounced dead. One hour later he was ordered by Prison Physician, John Gerin onto the operation table; three hours later at 11.15, the autopsy was completed and at

1.20 p. m. the quicklime and acid had been placed over the remains and the earth flattened over the grave.

To those to whom the weird appeals, the spectacle at the grave was more ghastly than the electrocution room. The prison graveyard is one mile south of the city, and sectioned off by barb wire fences. Immediately after Dr. Carlos F. MacDonald, the insanity expert, had finished the examination of the brain which he pronounced to be of a normal character, the body in entirety was placed in a wooden box and loaded into a dray.

To avoid attention and give the dray the appearance of a vehicle going to the depot, several large boxes were piled in on top, six barrels of quicklime completed the cargo. The wagon drove out of the north gate of the prison wall and hurried in a circuitous route by way of the freight depot toward the cemetery. The grave diggers had worked with such speed that less than seventy-five people had been attracted when the box was slipped into the pit and work of covering begun.

It was the action of the quicklime and the acid that created the ghastly features of the interment. The six barrels of quicklime were first emptied into the pit and then on this was poured several gallons of a quick-acting sulphuric acid. The acid and the lime had instant effect. A great cloud of steam arose and the spectators stepped back. The steam in increasing volume hung over the ground in a haze and finally gave place to smoke, caused by the action of the acid on the wood. The earth was dumped in as quickly as possible and thus sufficed to smother the burning, but though the burial had required only ten minutes, sufficient steam and smoke had escaped as to completely inundate the cemetery.

By the process used in the disposal of the body all danger of molestation was precluded. Previous experiments made last week had convinced the prison officials that quicklime alone would not be active enough and therefore this acid was resorted to. It was said by the attending physicians that the remains would be consumed within twenty-four hours.
