Lords May Rule On Martial Problem

(By The Canadian Press) LONDON, April 17 - The House of Lords may be asked to rule whether a wife's refusal of sexual relations constitutes desertion of her husband.

Desertion and adultery are the only causes for divorce in Britain. A London court ruled in a two-to-one opinion yesterday against a husband's divorce appeal which argued that such refusal amounted to desertion. The court gave him permission to take his case to the House of Lords, the highest appeal court for civil cases in Britain. His lawyers said they had not yet decided whether to pursue the appeal.

One lawyer with many years experience in divorce actions said that if the House of Lords ruled in favor of the plaintiff "it is likely that there would be many petitions on similar grounds."

"I am convinced that the number would be surprising and it is hardly exaggerating to call it colossal," he said. The husband's petition said his wife lived a normal life with him for a time after marriage, but that later she was "furnished with" sexual relations. He said they continued to live in the same apartment for a while without normal relations and then separated.

South Africa Limits Rights Of Asiatics

CAPETOWN, April 17 (Reuters) - The Asiatic Land Tenure and Indian Representation Bill was approved today by a vote of 78 to 40 in the House of Assembly after a 16-day debate. The bill restricts land purchases by Asiatics in Natal and Transvaal Provinces and provides for Indians to be represented in the Union Senate and Assembly by Europeans and on the Natal Provincial Council by two members who may be either Indian or European.

The bill is the latest endeavour to settle the controversial problem of relations between Indians and South Africans of European stock, a problem which has vexed the country since Indians were first imported into South Africa under indenture in the 1860s to cultivate the Natal sugar plantations down by the Cape.

Many settled in the country after serving their indenture terms and spread into Transvaal and the Orange Free State. Latest available figures, show Natal's Indian population in 1936 was about 250,000 while the European population was 190,549. The Indian population in the Transvaal at that time was estimated at about 50,000 compared with 80,758 Europeans.

O. P. A. Is Dealt Staggering Blow

WASHINGTON, April 17 (AP) - In a tremendous reversal against President Truman's stabilization policy, the House of Representatives today voted to extend the Office of Price Administration a series of staggering blows.

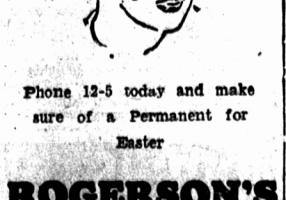
The action of the House today amounts to the repeal of price control. The bill has been loaded down with inflationary amendments which would make the law completely ineffective and impossible to administer.

"I hope this does not represent the final action of the House," the actions were in the form of amendments to O. P. A. extension legislation which were subject to later roll call votes. The bill has yet to be acted upon by the Senate.

One major amendment approved 139 to 122 would repeal the price controls on meat and live-poultry.

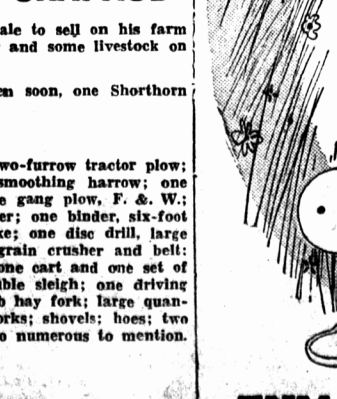
