WEST AUSTRALIA JEWS' HOME LAND

Territorial Organization Plans Foundation of Colony There as Headquarters—Russian Persecution Continues.

LONDON, May 15.—Although the public hears but little of the work done by the Ito, that is, the Jewish Territorial organization founded by Israel Zaagwill, it is nevertheless trying harder than ever to find a country in which Jews may settle down and call their own. It seems that Mesopotamia has now fallen in to the background, principally on account of the opposition of the Turkish government. And Western Australia has come into favor. Western Australia is by no means a rich region, so far as the Ito is concerned.

The Jews as De Plehva agrees with him in this, and if his life had not been cut short by the bomb of the assassin, he would have put into force his scheme for the Colonization of Manchuria with Russian Jews, so as to form a barrier against the Chinese. For such a purpose Russians had already in the South of Siberia proved useless, but De Plehva had greater hopes of the Jews.

The principal argument which Lucian Wolfe now puts forward in order to induce the West Australian government to accept the Ito scheme is that a greatly increased white population is urgently necessary in order to serve as a barrier against a yellow invasion, and for such a purpose no race would prove so valuable as the Jewish. Even so severe a critic of the Ito scheme as Wolfe is, however, is not averse to the idea of a Jewish colony in Australia.

In Russia the tale of Jewish persecution continues to unfold itself. The recent political crisis was hailed by the Russian Jews as promising some relief, for it was thought that whatever resulted the conditions of affairs could not grow worse and no regime could exceed in cruelty that of M. Stolypin. The order has apparently gone forth that the conscription of Europe is no more to be shocked by massacre, but the same object is to be obtained more thoroughly and without any scandal by means of relentless persecution.

ARBITRATION TREATY SUBMITTED YESTERDAY.

WASHINGTON, May 18.—The principle of arbitration of practically all disputes between nations, including even questions of vital interest and national honor, assumed vitality yesterday when Secretary Knox submitted to the British and French Ambassadors at Washington, the draft of a convention to serve as a basis of negotiations.
