Synopsis of Canadian North-West HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

ANY lands in Dominion of Dominion of Alberta, excepting land reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, or the estate of one-quarter section of 100 acres, more or less. Entry must be made personally at the local office for the district in which the land is situated. Entries must be made personally at the local office for the district in which the land is situated. The homesteader is required to perform the conditions of the contract with under one of the following plans: (1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years. (2) If the father or mother, if the father is deceased of the homesteader resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for the homestead, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land. (3) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his homestead, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land. Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands, Ottawa, of intention to apply for patent. W. W. GILBY, Deputy of the Minister of the Interior, N. 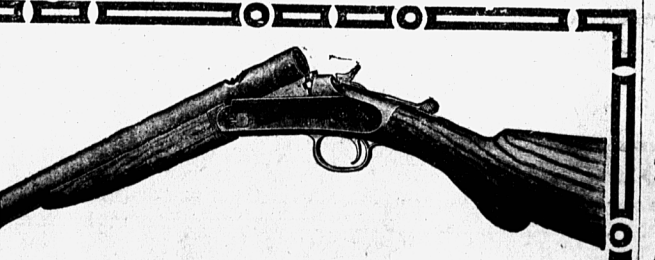
