THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT AND WOMEN

The Government is Timid of Taking Up The Case of The Suffragists Women Say They Must Use Violence.

LONDON, Dec. 30.—If the women suffragists of England have accomplished nothing else by their strenuous method of agitating they have at least so severely scared the members of the present British Government, that several of them have made a movement that under no circumstances will they speak at any more public meetings unless they receive a pledge from the leaders of the woman suffragists movement that they will not be assaulted or their lives endangered.

Mr. Gladstone who was recently attacked by furious women at Leeds, has declared that he will take no more risks of being made a target for anything the women want to fire at him, or of having to make ignominious exits. He further more has declared that he will not even be satisfied with pledges from the women suffragist leaders, but absolutely refuses to speak at any meetings where women will be admitted.

He makes an exception in the case of the wife of the chairman of the meeting, and a limited number of ladies whose pacific intentions are guaranteed by a great majority of the local liberal executive.

The leaders of the woman suffragist movement while deploring the fact that some of their followers have behaved in

rather disorderly manner, declare that some violence was, and probably will be for some time to come absolutely necessary to impress it upon the minds of the male voters that they are in earnest.

ZULU RISING IS CONSIDERED SERIOUS MATTER

Although Made Light Of By The Press a While Ago

LONDON, Dec. 30.—It is generally admitted that the conspiracy among the Zulus which was discovered a few weeks ago, and made light of by the official press, is far more serious than at first thought and that the slightest success on the part of the rebels may lead to a long and bloody war.

The action of the war department in not allowing newspapers correspondents to accompany the troops commanded by Colonel Mackenzie, has created a very bad impression and tended to strengthen the idea that the situation is exceedingly serious.

According to the latest cables received the troops have been prepared and supplied for a long campaign. The advance of the British soldiers is made exceedingly difficult by the miserable weather which has made all roads and trails almost impassable.

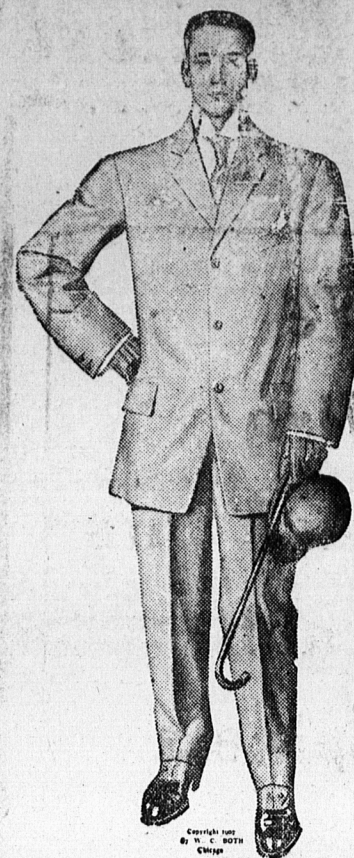

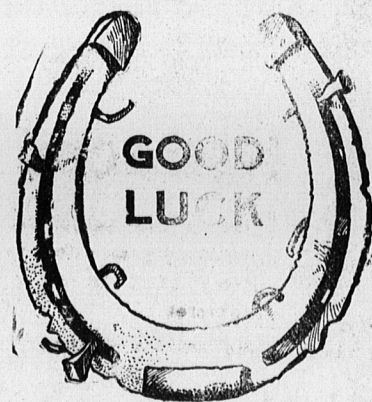
