ST. THOMAS, N. W. I., Jan. 2.—General Antenor Firmin, the Haytien minister to Great Britain, in an interview today denied that he was connected with any revolutionary movement.

He left his post at London without notifying the Haytien government of his intention and embarked at Bordeaux December 18 on the steamer Montreal, arriving here Sunday.

CANON BROOKS DIES AFTER USEFUL LIFE.

KENTVILLE, Jan. 2.—The death occurred on Sunday afternoon of Rev. Canon Isaac Brock. Dr. Brock had been in his usual health until Friday, when he was seized with a sudden attack of grippe, which terminated fatally. Dr. Brock was born in Hampshire, England, in 1828.

In 1883 he removed to Nova Scotia, having been appointed rector of Londonderry. In a year's time he was made president of King's college, Windsor, which position he held with great credit until he came to Kentville as rector of St. James church. Eight years ago he retired from active duties, but for several years took spiritual services and acted as rector in charge for many large churches in eastern Canada.

Five years ago he had a paralytic seizure which, tho his mind was unimpaired, left him partially helpless. For several years he was able to drive a motor, but for the past year his only vehicle had been the veranda. He delighted to see his many friends and his mind was clear to the last. The Anglican church has met with a severe loss in the death of this scholarly, cultured gentleman who at the call "gave his pure soul into his captain, Christ, under whose banner he had served so long."

Mrs. Brock predeceased her husband some ten years ago. He is survived by three sons and three daughters. The sons are Cecil, and Alfred, Chicago. The three daughters are Mrs. C. Lee Raymond, Woodstock, N. B.; Miss Kathleen Brock, Montreal, and Mrs. C. L. Tufts, Kentville.

Dr. Brock has for the past ten years made his home with his daughter in Kentville. The funeral will take place on Wednesday afternoon at two o'clock.

FORMER MONTREAL MAN IS FOUND DEAD.

SALT LAKE CITY, Utah, Jan. 2.—A frozen body found yesterday in a gravel pit north of the city proved today to be that of Allan MacGregor, an advertising manager and piano salesman. From letters he left, it is inferred that he poisoned himself and then retired to the pit to die.

MacGregor came from Montreal, but had lived in many parts of the world. His later life was embittered by a separation from his young wife in Australia. A sealed letter was found addressed to Horace Davis, advertising manager of the Montreal Standard. Davis is to receive all his property for a purpose, MacGregor said that Davis would know.
