SASKATCHEWAN ELECTIONS ARE STILL IN SOME DOUBT

There is a Possibility However that the Government Will be Sustained By a Slight Majority—Latest Returns Give Scott and Haultain Each Nine Seats With Seven Seats still In Doubt—Constituencies Claimed By Each.

MONTREAL, Dec. 18.—(Special).—A Regina despatch says that the result of the Saskatchewan elections is still in some doubt though there is a possibility that the government will be sustained by a slight majority.

Of these in doubt Haultain claims three and Scott three. The final result may give Scott thirteen seats and Haultain twelve.
