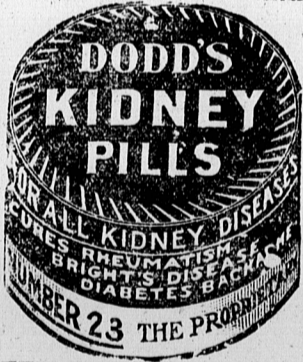

RACING CIRCLES STIRRED BY ANTI-GAMBLING MOVE

MONTREAL, Nov 30—English racing circles were stirred recently by the first move of the anti-racing element to test the legality of Continental betting. This is, whether it is within the bounds of the law which prohibits street betting for bookmakers who lived in England to advertise their number of years in the continent. For a majority of the big layers of odds have inserted advertisements in the newspapers giving Holland as their headquarters, while at the same time they live in London or thereabouts. Not alone do they do a regular betting business through the mails, but some supply a list of tips on all races as well as other important points of information for a nominal figure.

A man named Graham Brown acted as detective for the Anti-Gambling League, and in order to secure evidence, it seems, opened an account with a bookmaker named Thomas Henry Dey, who has offices at 40 Old Bond street, London, and who advertises to carry on business at Middleburg, Holland, his telegraphic address being "Honesty," Holland. Dey advertises that he will do betting business with anyone who wishes to do betting business with him. On September 30 Brown wrote to Dey expressing a desire to bet, and Dey sent him a book of rules and it is said that several transactions took place in London.

After a couple of weeks or so Story Dean, a lawyer, appeared at the Great Marlborough Street Police Court before Magistrate Mead and asked for a summons for Dey, stating that he had defrauded Brown in the betting. The magistrate was very careful about the points in the case, and he said he could not see his way to grant a summons on Brown's behalf, as he considered him an accomplice in the offence which was said to have been committed. After a lot of fencing on the part of the lawyer he finally placed some letters with the magistrate which would show that the vital part of the wager was done in London, not in Holland. The application for the summons was not granted, but the magistrate adjourned the case for some days until he could investigate more thoroughly and read the correspondence between Brown and the bookmaker.

The case has aroused a good deal of curiosity among the racing element, for if the summons is granted it will mean a lot of trouble for the bookmakers who advertise their business in Holland.
