CHICAGO, October 18.—The Chicago Clearing House Association today sent to James Keeley, managing editor of the Chicago Tribune, a check for \$5,000, the amount of the reward offered by the association for the capture of Paul O. Stensland, the former president of the Milwaukee Avenue State bank, who was arrested in Tangier. The check was at once turned over to the receiver of the bank to be included among the assets. In addition to sending this check to the receiver of the bank, the Tribune, which bore the entire expense incident to the pursuit, capture and return of Stensland, has made a present to the taxpayers of Cook county of the total amount expended in the undertaking which amounted to another \$5,000.
