EARTHQUAKE IN CALABRIA WAS SERIOUS

The Pope and the Government Help the Sufferers

ROME, Oct. 28.—Little additional news was received here this morning from Calabria, which was visited by earth shocks on October 23. The bad weather continues in the south and it is feared that many persons are likely to lose their lives as the result of exposure. Fear of a repetition of the earthquakes are preventing them from returning to the villages. Many of the homeless people have erected tents or are living under other temporary covering. A few fresh shocks were experienced yesterday, but no further damage has been reported.

The Pope has sent supplies of money to the clergy of Calabria for the relief of their suffering parishioners and has ordered that the churches be kept open day and night, for the use of the homeless. The government also has forwarded \$20,000 to the Calabrian authorities for use in the relief work and has taken every other step possible to help the sufferers.

LABOUCHERE MAKES FIERCE ATTACK ON LORDS

The Very Plain Talk He Indulged in Regarding Titled Families

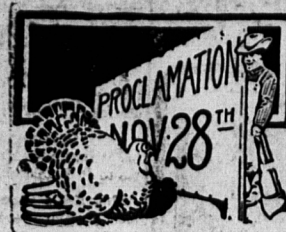
LONDON, October 29.—"A dissolute nobility, descended from a tainted ancestry," is the terrible indictment brought against the bulk of English peerage by Henry Labouchere, the fearless editor and critic.

Resorting to no soft artifice of words to hide the severity of the arraignment the editor of the "Truth" declares that the majority of the holders of titles in England to-day are the weakling descendants of infamous forebears.

He mercilessly pillories some of the greatest names and titles in England and declares the present holders of them to be descended from illicit unions and flagrant blissions of the past.

He declares that some of the fairest estates in England are vested in descendants of illegitimate offspring of former kings and great nobles, children of the mistresses of kings and powerful rulers.

Much has been said of tainted money and questionable business methods in America but there have been no attacks on the homes of the master freebooters of finance. With ruthless hand Labouchere tears back the curtain from the ancient private life of many of the greatest families in England. He points out that the governing body in the House of Lords is composed of men descended from robber barons and weak-moraled favorites.

Synopsis of Canadian North-West HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 24, not reserved may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section (40 acres, more or less).

Any location for entry must be made person by the applicant at a Dominion Land Agency or Sub-agency for the district in which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may however, be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of an intending home steader.

The homesteader is required to perform the home-stead duties under one of the following plans:

(1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) A homesteader may, if he so desire permit the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. Joint ownership in land will not meet this requirement.

(3) If the father or mother, if the father is deceased, of homesteader has permanent residence on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon a homestead entered for by him in the vicinity such homesteader may perform his own residence duties by living with the father or mother.

(4) The term "vicinity" in the two preceding paragraphs is defined as meaning not more than nine miles in a direct line, exclusive of the width of road allowances crossed in the measurement.

(5) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with parents or on farming land owned by himself must notify the Agent for the district of such intention.

Six months notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa of intention to apply for patent.

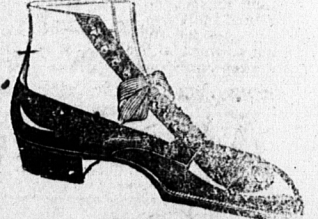
