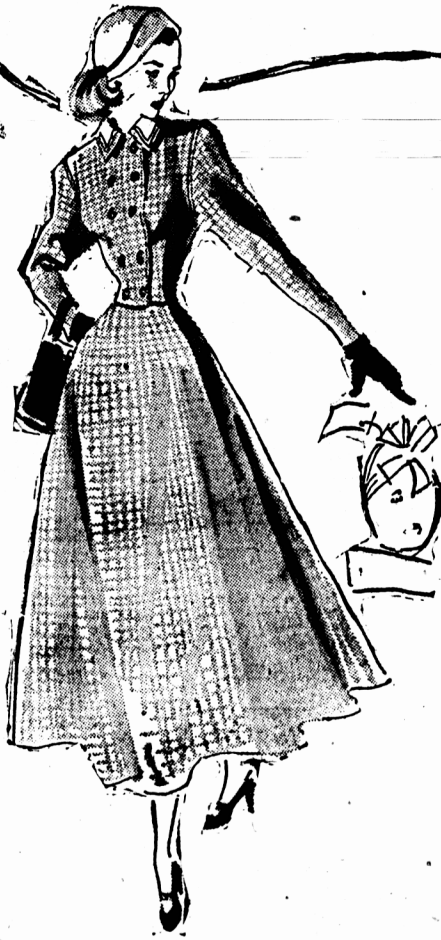

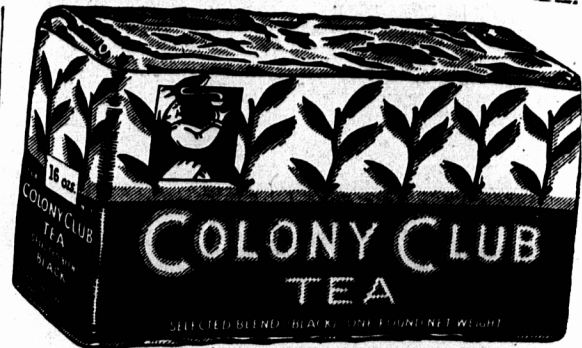

The gross amount taken will likely reach \$3,000 when all the figures are computed. The money raised will be used for the various service projects of the club. More articles were received from local and national firms than ever before in the history of these auctions. Three young pigs donated by Lockard Woodworkers of Moncton were sold for \$38.00. One of these animals also brought in some money on his own by visiting various homes around town. Nine telephones were used to handle the calls and these were not sufficient at times when the rush was on. The number of calls tabulated was 2,536. The telephone
