FINANCIAL NEWS BRIEFS

WINNIPEG, Aug. 18 - Good harvesting weather the past two weeks has prevailed in Saskatchewan in the north and central portions of Saskatchewan where crop outlook is most favorable about 75 per cent of wheat is cut and in the northwestern part about 60 per cent incompletely. The weekly crop report from Ottawa says that harvesting generally is going on in advance was not entirely unexpected and until moisture comes in the Argentine market may continue to be somewhat resistant. Liverpool was more encouraging yesterday and may be the same again today. The top of the advance was not entirely unexpected on all such bulges. However, we again expect a steady to stronger tone today if the Argentine situation remains unchanged.

MONTREAL, Aug. 18 - International Petroleum - Production July and 7 months. Production highest in company's history. July production up 1.3 per cent, and 7 months up 3.7 per cent.

British American Oil - Financial Control reports business showing excellent advances this year as compared with last year.

NEW YORK, Aug. 18 - According to Dow Jones the London market is a little better this morning, volume is small. News from far east situation show no improvement. The senate confirmed the nomination of Black for justice of the Supreme Court by a vote of 63 to 18. All indications point to an adjournment of Congress on Saturday unless by change the Wage and Hour Bill is brought up for discussion. The chances are against this. Goodrich reported \$1.90 for first half of the year against \$1.47 in the first six months of last year. Dividend meetings scheduled for today include American Tel. Lone Star Cement, Raybestos, Manhattan and Youngstown Sheet and Tube. The market will probably be irregular again today, but would expect some selective strength.

Textile - To reopen three mills tomorrow, with any wage increase granted under fair wage act to be retroactive.

MONTREAL, Aug. 18 - (CP) - A firmer trend appeared for eggs on Montreal open produce markets today while butter eased slightly. Graded egg shipments in cartons or less were quoted at 28 to 28 1/2 cents a dozen for grade A-large, 26 to 26 1/2 for A-medium, 22 1/2 to 23 for B-large and 20 to 20 1/2 for C. Butter was quoted at 26 1-2 cts a pound for cartons or less of No. 1 while lots to retailers were 27 1-2 for solids and 28 for prints. Potatoes - Que. new whites No. 2 80's 40 to 50.

Livestock

MONTREAL, Aug. 18 - (CP) - Through lack of offerings, cattle prices were unestablished today in early dealings on Montreal livestock markets, while prices on other divisions held steady at previous levels. Receipts: Cattle 110, calves 188, sheep and lambs 94, hogs 43. Veal calves ranged from \$6 to \$8 with drivers from \$4.50 to \$6 and grassers from \$3.50 to \$4.25. Good ewes and wethers went at \$8.50 with culls and bucks at \$7.50. Sheep sold mostly at \$3 with a few yearlings up to \$5. Bacon hogs, fed and watered, made \$10.75 with selects at the usual \$1 to \$2 a hundredweight while sows went from \$6.90 to \$7.50. Hog prices were lower on Maritime markets at \$12 rail grade, \$10 off cars and \$9.65 off trucks. Sows sold at \$8.95 rail grade and \$6.85 live weight. Grain fed steers sold up to \$9.50 with butcher cows at \$4 and cutters from \$3 down. Lambs brought \$7.50 to \$7.75. Calf prices were unquoted.
