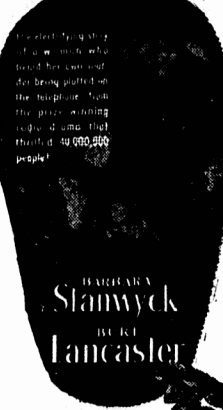

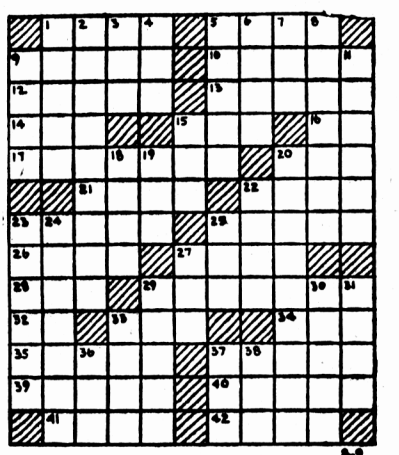


FAMILY INCOME Family allowance payments in Canada during 1949 will total \$276,000,000—equal to \$325 every minute.
