THE RHODES SCHOLARSHIPS.

Two men of Anglo-Saxon blood have in recent years signified themselves by an imperial generosity devoted to the dissemination of knowledge and the promotion of the higher learning.

But it is of Rhodes and his great bequest that we propose to speak. Unlike Carnegie, who is making himself his own executor, Rhodes devoted his life to the furtherance of ambitions and patriotic plans and left the application of his vast fortune to public uses to be made by others.

By his will the late Cecil Rhodes provides for scholarships in the twenty-one colleges of Oxford to be held for three years by young men from every British Colony and every State and Territory of the United States.

In every three years almost one hundred young Americans will thus, under the provisions of Cecil Rhodes' will, be sent to Oxford to complete their university education, with other young men from the Provinces of Canada, the States of Australia, from the East and West Indies and thousands from the British Isles.
