Canadian Foundries and Forgings—No indication of let up in companies business with third quarter continuing satisfactory rate of improvement experienced first six months.

Dividend Index Up—Nesbitt Thompson index on new recovery high at 138.3 in October against 138.0 in Sept. and 111.3 in October 1936.

Eldorado—Company engineers cognizant of possible declining radium price now 25,000 per gram and have planned for wide commercialization of radium and related elements from the Great Bear pitchblende and silver recovery is also large.
