**Contract Bridge**

**BOLDNESS REWARDED**

East's double of the less-than-games contract in today's deal was somewhat risky, but he knew he could count on his own partnership for excellent defense. The result justified his confidence. Obviously, South "stuck his neck out" when he waited for the second round of bidding before coming in with his non-too-strong club suit, and East probably sensed the fact when he risked the double. West opened the spade king as when East played the eight, continued the suit for two more rounds. Declarer ruffed and led the heart queen. West put up the ace and now shifted to the queen of diamonds. Declarer allowed this to hold, but when West led a second diamond, declarer won with a

mond trick, was quite willing to let declarer ruff a diamond in dummy--because East saw that if his partner could force out the ten of trumps by producing any trump as high as the six, East's own club holding would be safeguarded and would automatically win a trick. East was assured of a trump trick no matter how declarer played the suit. Thus, East-West collected a 300-point penalty.
