The natives are greatly excited by the news of the bombardment of Casablanca and the more fanatical uremas are demanding that the sultan shall lead a holy war to sweep the foreigners into the sea.

It is probable that this movement will reach the Kabyles. To prevent the possibility of a holy war spreading among the tribesmen it is expected that the government will prohibit meetings.

OTTAWA, Sept. 2.—Major Ponsonby has cabled to Lord Grey as follows: "Marionbad, August 31, 1907. 'The King is a-leveld to hear of the news of the disaster to the Quebec Bridge, and wishes you to convey his heartfelt sympathy with the relatives and friends of all who have lost their lives in the sad calamity (Signed.) PONSONBY."

The Viceroy of India cables the Governor General as follows:—"Simla, August 31, 1907. 'Please tell Lieut. Governor of Quebec deeply grieved, horrible Bridge accident. (Signed.) MINTO."
