And it is because husbands and wives, as a general thing, see too much of each other, and not enough of other people, that they get to the point where conversation has been exhausted between them.

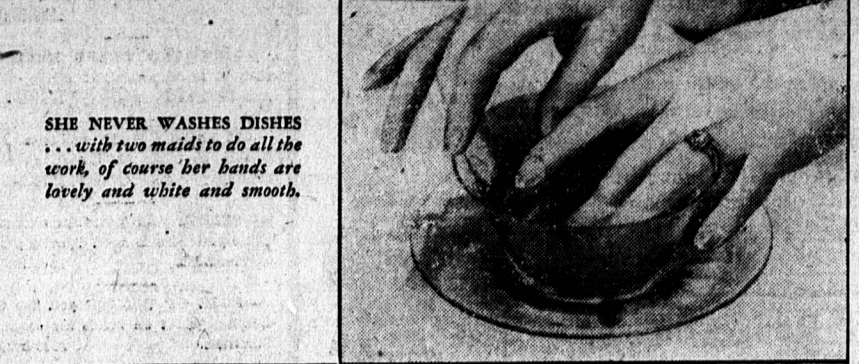

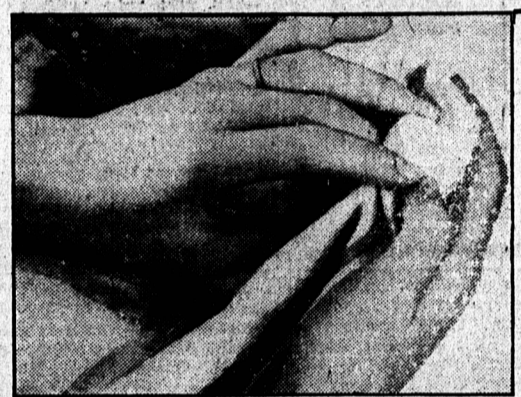

Household Hints

Starch To give starch a brilliant luster, soak for 5 or 6 hours 1 ounce of white gum-arabic in 1 quart of water; then add 2 ounces borax and heat to boiling point. Now add 1 ounce glycerine. When cool, strain and bottle for use. Stir 1 tablespoonful of this mixture into every three quarts of starch used.

out a Turkish towel in hot water, and press it against the throat.
