Stock Markets At A Glance

NEW YORK, Aug. 29 — (AP)— Selected stocks, including airmails managed to keep the market recovery ball rolling today although many stocks, rails and motors were unable to overcome light selling. Transfers totaled 920,000 shares smallest in a week compared with 1,260,000 the day before. The Associated Press 60-stock composite was off .1 of a point at 86.8, first decline since Aug. 20. CHICAGO, Aug. 29 — (AP)— Further short-covering prompted by reports of foreign demand caused another sharp advance in rye futures today, with gains reaching well over 2 cents a bushel at times. Wheat also advanced slightly after an early setback, but corn and oats were off most of the session.

TORONTO, Aug. 29 — (CP)— Stocks drifted downward to show index losses of .9 to .34 for the trading group in today's Toronto Exchange Market. Western Oil finished higher by .26. The Toronto Exchange has decided to continue the Saturday close-down indefinitely; there will be no market session on Labor Day, Monday, September 3. Two new stocks have been listed by the exchange, Concor Mining Company Limited and New Calumet Mines Limited will be called for trading tomorrow, August 30. WENNIPIG, Aug. 29 — (CP)— Trading in the futures was fairly active today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange with prices firm. Offerings were generally light, with locals and commission. No export business was reported but there were indications that Portugal was seeking 900,000 bushels of wheat, although no sales were confirmed. There was an inquiry for export rye, now in small supply. MONTREAL, Aug. 29 — (CP)— Strength in papers featured trading today on the Montreal Stock Exchange and Curb Market, and the average for the trading group ran increase of almost three points. Utilities were easier. Quebec Pulp and Paper Preferred, ahead 3 1/2 points at one time, closed one point higher. Howard Smith, Minnesota and Ontario, Powell River, Price Common, Abitibi six per cent, Consolidated, Domtar and Fraser also gained while Bathurst, B. International Paper and Price Preferred eased. Trading box score: 106,800 shares; mines 71,700; industrials 34,900; stocks higher 48; lower 47; unchanged 4.
