The Police Committee referred to the prevalence of corner loafers, boys staying away from school and immoral conduct, etc., and asked that stricter measures be taken to enforce the laws governing same. H. P. Woods was appointed school trustee in place of the late Dr. McLellan. Council adjourned to meet next Monday when the question of improving the Market Hall entrance and the matter of getting information re water works will come up.

Farmers as a rule lay in their stock of seeds, such as wheat, oats, clover, timothy, etc., early in the season, but the supply of seeds for the vegetable garden is left for "any old time." After the farm crop is in, is plenty time in the estimation of most farmers for a vegetable garden. Now farmers this order of things should be reversed. As a rule the garden plot is fit for tilling before the rush of farm work commences, and if it is not planted before that, it is generally left to take care of itself. 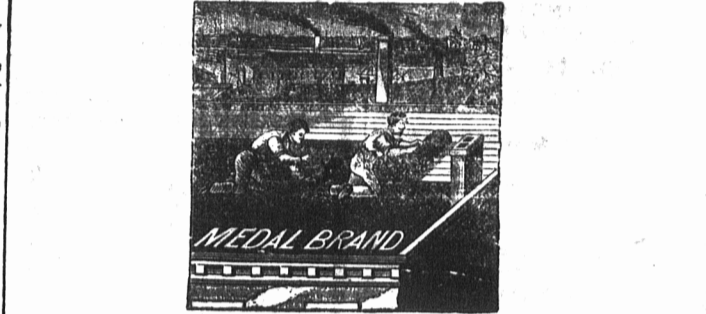
