**Gains Edge Out Losses On Montreal Stock Exchange**

MONTREAL, Sept. 22 — (CP)—Gains, mainly fractional, edged out losses in dull dealings in the industrial section of the stock exchange and curb market today. The mines were quieter and generally mixed.

The exchange's closing averages listed banks off .14 to .2720; utilities off .4 to .763; industrials up .35 to .118.5; papers off .259 to .342.23. A gold off .03 to .80.24. Volume was 33,700 industrial shares and 145,300 mining shares.

Papers were listless with International, B. C. forest products and Brown Company all leading 1-8 at Massey 2, and 5 1-8 respectively. Massey lost 1-4 at 15 1-2 in industrials and Band & Millen "A" dropped 5 cents to 145. Ottawa Car advanced 1-8 to 7 5-8.

Utilities displayed more activity during the session. Bell Telephone went ahead 1 1-2 points at 172 1-2 and Southmount added a cent at 43. Traded on the exchange today were 14,896 Bell Telephone rights at 5 1-4. Shawinigan dropped 1-4 at 21 3-4 while International Utilities was off 1-8 at 12 1-4.

**Stocks Unchanged At N. Y. Yesterday**

NEW YORK, Sept. 22 — (AP)—The stock market snapped its string of eight successive Monday declines today but was unable to make any headway.

Some of the pivotal steels, motors and rubbers climbed in the plus column in late dealings and imparted enough strength to permit The Associated Press 60-stock composite to finish unchanged at 64.8. Many railroad stocks, under water much of the day, managed to trim their losses.

Canadian issues diminished today but were inactive for the most part. Dome Mines was down 5-8, Distillers Secagrams was down 1-2 while Canadian Pacific dropped 1-8. On the curb, Giant Yellow Knife lost 1-8.

New 1947 highs were established by Skelly Oil at 87, Anacosta Wire which closed at 61 5-8 and Pennsylvania Coal & Coke, finishing at 54 5-8. Bethlehem, a firm spot most of the session, closed up 5-8 at 87 1-2; General Motors was ahead 1-4 at 59 and Goodrich 1-2 at 55 1-4. Other gains were registered by Owens-Illinois, Pullman, American Woolen, International Harvester, Sunray Oil, Olivier Corp. and Westinghouse Electric. Fractionally off were Union Pacific at 136, Southern Railway at 38, Northern Pacific at 20 1-4, Standard Oil (N.J.), Phillips Petroleum, Texas Co., Douglas Aircraft, Glenn Martin, Kennecott and International Nickel. American Can dropped a point at 83 1-2.
