By Frederick Gardner Associated Press Financial Writer NEW YORK, Oct. 3 (AP)—The stock market tried to rally a bit today but there were too many offerings and not enough bidders and leaders fell fractions to around 2 points.

The recovery effort came early in the session, adding a point to values but it didn't last long. Throughout the preceding session slow comparison with recent war market. There was some price improvement toward the close.

Transfers totaled 1,022,750 shares compared with 837,890 Monday. The Associated Press average of 60 representative stocks dropped .5 of a point at 32.3.

The Canadian section was fractionally stronger. Slight gains were made by Dome, McIntyre, Walkers, Canadian Marconi and Pont. Seagram and Lake Shore were easy.

Stocks down at the finish included U. S. Steel, Bethlehem, Chrysler, Goodyear, Douglas Aircraft, Santa Fe, Chesapeake and Ohio, American Telephone, Texas Corp., Westinghouse, Electric, Du Pont, Union Carbide, American Smelting, Western Union, J. I. Case and International Harvester.

As on yesterday a few amusement issues were favored and Pathe and Loews had small gains.

MONTREAL, Oct. 3 (CP)—After wavering between plus and minus for most of the session, the stock market backtracked in late dealings today. Turnover was light.
