History of Rival Candidates

ALBERT OTTINGER

Albert Ottinger Republican Candidate for Governor, began his political career as a youthful stump speaker on the Bowery, New York, back in the days of McKinley's first presidential campaign.

He became a district leader in the Bronx, New York City, and fought his way through a number of stiff battles. The year 1912 found him serving as Republican executive member for the 18th Assembly District. In 1914, he was defeated in a three-cornered fight for election to Congress from the 19th Congressional district. He continued to divide his time between his legal practice in New York City and various city and country political activities.

In 1916 he was elected to the New York State Senate. Among about 30 bills sponsored by him during his term in the senate was an amendment to the Civil Rights Law penalizing discrimination against any person because of race, creed or color.

In 1921 he was appointed an assistant United States attorney general by President Harding.

Mr. Ottinger was first elected attorney-general of New York State in 1924. When he was re-elected in 1926 he was the only undefeated Republican candidate on the state ticket. He was still in office when he was nominated as the Republican candidate for governor.

Mr. Ottinger is a Jew and unmarried.

FRANKLIN DELANO ROOSEVELT

Franklin Delano Roosevelt, Democratic Candidate for Governor, wanted to be a sailor but became instead an attorney, politician and business man.

His first taste of politics came in 1910, just a few years after his graduation from college when, despite the jeers of his opponents at "the college kid", he was elected to the New York State Senate. Since that time politics has been with him a business fully as much as his legal profession or his connection with several large financial houses.

Franklin Roosevelt was born January 30, 1882, in Hyde Park, Dutchess County. His father, James Roosevelt, was a fourth cousin of President Roosevelt, while his mother, Sarah Delano, was a member of a well-known New York family. James Roosevelt was for many years vice-president of the Delaware and Hudson Railroad and president of the Champlain Transportation Company.

After graduating from Harvard in 1904, with the degree of A. B., he attended Columbia University Law School and upon his graduation in 1907 was admitted to the bar.

As a state senator he fought Tammany Hall and its leader, the late Charles F. Murphy. Roosevelt won, and in 1918 and again in 1920 he had the support of Tammany.

As assistant secretary of the navy he was responsible for making up a coast patrol of privately-owned yachts which were turned over to the government; for the 110-foot submarine chaser adopted by this country and subsequently by European nations, and for the handling of the greatly increased civilian personnel of the navy.

In 1918, he was urged to run for governor of New York State and was promised the support of Tammany Hall—his one-time enemy, but declined because of his work in Washington.

Two years later he accepted the Democratic nomination for vice-president but was swept to defeat in the Harding landslide. Four years later in 1924, he was stricken with infantile paralysis, and since that time has waged a constant fight against the ravages of that disease.

In 1924, Franklin Roosevelt hobbled to the platform on crutches to place the name of Governor Alfred E. Smith in nomination for the national convention.

Recently he has been experimenting with a possible cure at Warm Springs, Ga., and it was there he received the news of his nomination for Governor by the Democratic state convention.

UNIVERSITY NOT EAGER TO ADMIT WOMEN

TORONTO, Ont., Nov. 7.—(CP)—The records of University College show that it is now 44 years since women have been admitted. Prof. Malcolm Wallace addressing the University Women's Club, pointed out there were grave fears and doubts as to the advisability of admitting women to university. In the intervening years, however, women had established their status as students and more than justified their admission into university life. Personally, he thought, perhaps the intellectual instinct was stronger in women even than in men, and that women would often make greater sacrifices to obtain higher education.

HINDENBURG GODFATHER OF 5,300 CHILDREN DURING HIS PRESIDENCY

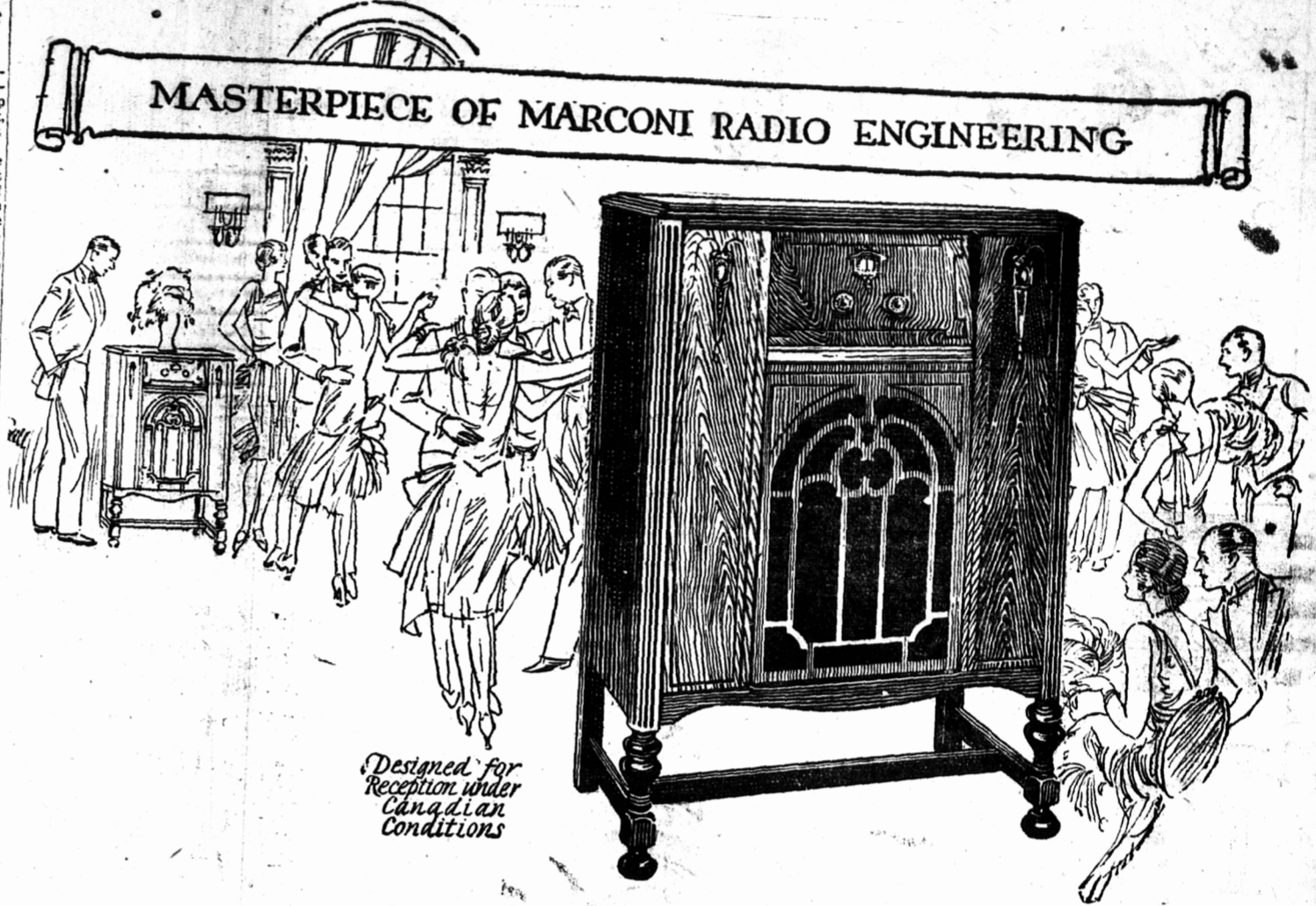
BERLIN, Nov. 7.—To be godfather to 5,300 children is the unusual record achieved by President von Hindenburg in the course of his three and a half years in the presidency.

Amplifying the pre-war tradition whereby the emperor accepted godparenthood to every seventh male born in any family, President von Hindenburg became godfather to every seventh child irrespective of sex.

Each of his godchildren receives a handwritten letter of acceptance by the chief executive and in needy cases a moderate money present. The president also writes a personal letter of congratulation to all couples celebrating their iron, golden or diamond wedding anniversaries.
